WHATYOU NEED TO DO

Event Criteria

Events will need to take place
from 10th - 14th October 2022.
They must be open to the public,
affordable and accessible.
Organisations do not need to be a
member of CADA NI to be included
in the festival, but all events must
meet the event criteria.

Event Organisation

You need to take responsibility for organising and hosting the event ensuring all relevant insurances, licences and health & safety requirements are met, if applicable.

Event Promotion

You need to promote the event and invite audiences, manage event numbers and complete an evaluation.

ONE WORLD FESTIVAL

SELECTION CRITERIA

The Selection Committee will use the criteria below to determine the events to include in the official festival programme.

- One World Festival events must be in keeping
 with the vision, mission and aims of the festival.

 Events should aim to increase awareness of the
 Global South, promote understanding of issues
 that affect the lives of the poorest people and
 inspire action in our communities towards a just,
 peaceful and sustainable world.
- 2. Events should aim to give a voice to people in or from the Global South, challenge negative stereotypes, and actively promote gender equality in terms of representation on panels, line-ups and messaging.
- 3. Preference will be given to events run by more than one organisation, as we value collaboration and partnership between organisers.

- 4. Organisers must confirm they have sufficient public liability insurance for the event and should carry out a full risk assessment, if applicable.
 CADA will not be held responsible for any accident, loss or injury arising from an event.
- 5. Events must not promote a political party organisation or other public campaign, which the festival committee has not approved.
- 6. Organisers may use their own branding at events but One World Festival branding and promotional materials must be given equal publicity at events.
- 7. Fundraising events where a premium ticket price is charged, or high value donations solicited (e.g. a Gala Dinner), or participants have to raise sponsorship to take part in an event, will not be included in the festival except by prior agreement of the festival committee. However, for events where a performer or speaker donates their time and standard ticket prices are charged (where appropriate), any net contribution raised may be retained by the organisation running the event.
